About the University

The Guru Kashi University was founded by the Balaji Education Trust in Talwandi Sabo in 1997, and it served as the cornerstone for education in the region. Guru Gobind Singh Polytechnic, the initial college, opened in 1998, with graduate and postgraduate programs later added. Guru Gobind Singh College of Engineering & Technology was founded in 2001, while Guru Gobind Singh College of Education opened in 2005. In 2006, the GGS Institute of IT and Research and the GGS College of Nursing were established. The Punjab Act No. 37 of 2011 founded Guru Kashi University. Since then, the institution has grown and served the needs of the local, national, and worldwide communities in the midst of natural beauty.

Because it is located in a rural location, the university caters to agricultural needs and has launched a number of programs through the College of Agriculture. It has two accreditations: ICAR and PCAR. To increase research and teaching exposure, the university has formed partnerships with peer universities and institutions at the local, national, and worldwide levels. The institution offers over 50 undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral degrees and uses a Choice Based Credit System. At all levels, the curriculum is centered on learning outcomes, and a Multiple Entry and Exist system has been implemented.

With outstanding facilities and chances for sports and cultural activities, students receive high-level instruction in both individual and team events.

The campus is located 5 kilometers from Shri Damdama Sahib, Talwandi Sabo, in a rural region spanning 75+ acres. In addition to academic and administrative blocks, it has dorms, canteens, agriculture farms, orchards, Herbal Garden, gymnasium, sports grounds, well-kept parks, auditorium, open-air theatre, library, computer center, and open learning centres for students in all academic blocks.

Crime Scene Competition

Team Eligibility & Composition:

- The event is open for Students/Research Scholars/Academicians/ Industry Experts and Practitioners from fields like Law, Forensic Science and Criminology.
- Single member participation is allowed. If it is a team, only two members are allowed.
- There can be multiple entries/registrations from an institution.

Rules and Regulations:

- On the day of the competition, the participants will be given a basic orientation of the competition and briefed about the background of the crime scene set up.
- Participants shall be provided with the required stationary.
- Crime scene shall be open to observation for 15 minutes only.
- The participants are then required to observe, find evidence, clues, ask for reports, make notes and sketches.
- After the observation, 45 minutes shall be provided to prepare a report.

Pro Bono Presentation

Team eligibility and composition:

- The event is open to law graduates and post-graduates only.
- Single member participation is allowed. If it is a team, maximum two members are allowed.
- There can be only one entry from an institution.

Rules and Regulations:

- The participants shall present their pro bono projects, initiatives, or research findings to a panel of esteemed judges.
- The participants shall make a written submission along-with a PPT presentation of 20 minutes to the panel.
- The written submission must include photographs, departmental reports and copies of other relevant documents related to the Pro Bono activity conducted. This is required for vetting purposes.
- Pro Bono initiatives could be work done through legal aid clinics, community outreach programs, policy advocacy campaigns, or research projects.
- Your presentations must highlight the innovative strategies, challenges overcome, and outcomes achieved through your pro bono endeavours.

Team eligibility and composition:

- The event is open for Students/Research Scholars/Academicians/ Industry Experts and Practitioners from fields like Law, Forensic Science and Criminology.
- Only single member participation is allowed (no teaming allowed).
- There can be multiple entries/registrations from an institution.

Rules and Regulations:

1. In the First round, a brief description of 15 cases shall be provided to each team/participant. 20 minutes will be provided to the participants to answer with the name of the parties to the case and citations. Six participants will qualify for the final round.
2. In case of a tie-breaker, of landmark judgments shall be provided and the teams will have to identify the name of the cases. No usage of internet will be allowed for this round.
3. In the final round, 6 situational problems and 50 landmark judgments will be given and participants have to find which case law is relevant to which problem within 60 minutes.
4. Use of mobile phone or any reference materials is strictly prohibited.
5. A Computer with internet facility and access to google will be provided.

- The evaluation will be based on **depth of legal analysis, legal reasoning and interpretation**, and the **conclusion provided**.

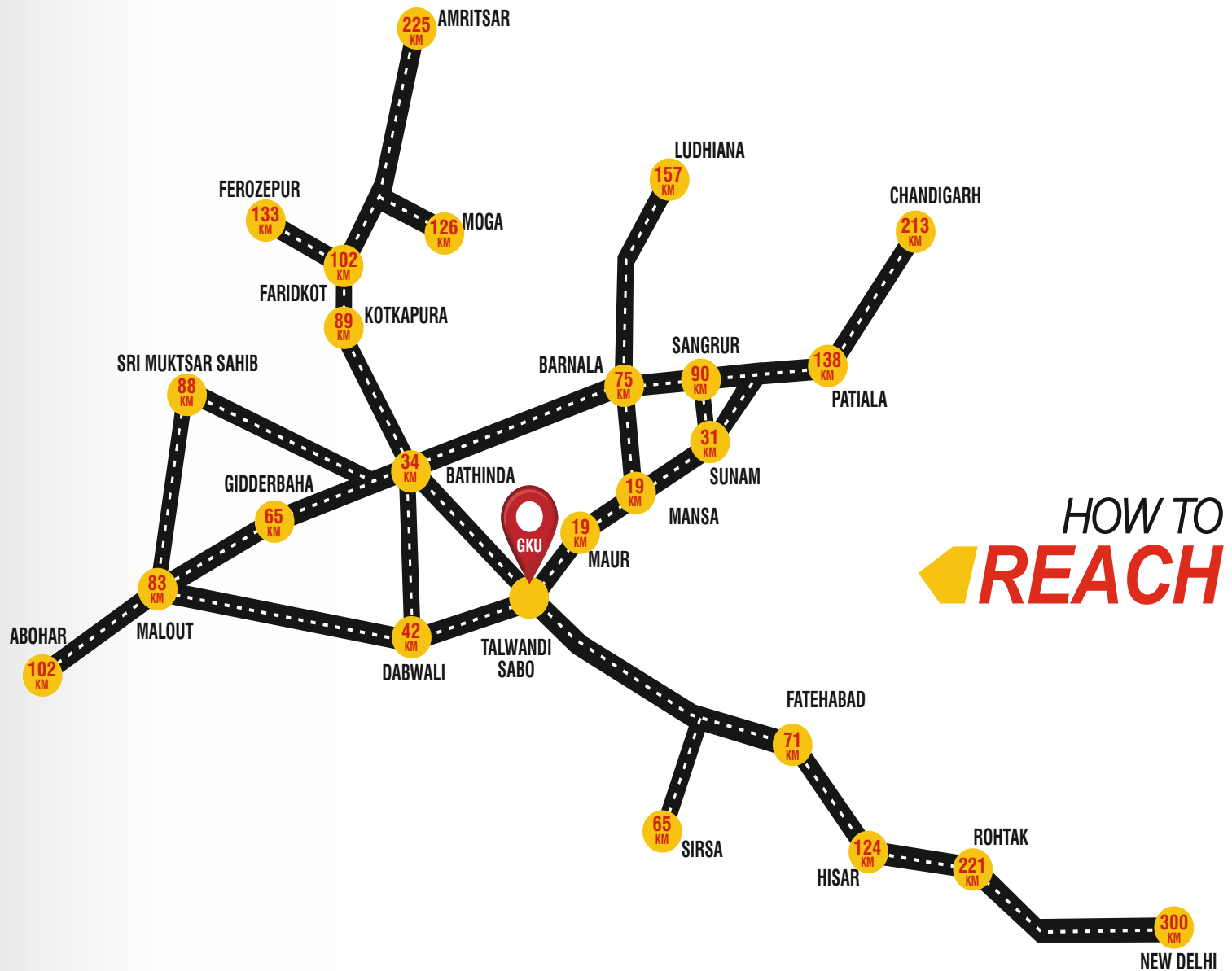
